We would like to have your recipe along with your entry. We will be auctioning off the entries after the judging and the winners have been announced, proximately 2:00 P.M., so please have your entry on a non-returnable container.

PRIZES

The winners will receive a 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place ribbon and a Community Cookbook in each category. One Cookbook per contestant, if you should win in more then one category you will only receive one Cookbook.
