Each department head provided council with plans for the 2006-07 fiscal year and Noeldner reviewed those goals that had already been accomplished and updated the goals. A complete set of the changed goals will become part of the budget plan for the 2006-2007 fiscal year and will be approved by the council at a later council meeting.
