**POWER COST ADJUSTMENTS:** All electric bills include a Power Cost Adjustment that is calculated monthly based on the actual cost of power purchased by the Village vs the projected cost. This adjustment could be an addition or subtraction and effects all rate payers proportionately. Standard rates are based on long-term projections of power cost that can be higher or lower than the actual cost when power is purchased for distribution throughout the Village.
