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Fence Guidelines (residential only)

Please review the zoning ordinance for all requirements

- 1. Complete accessory application (enclosed)
- 2. Along with the completed application you will need to show:
 - A. Proof of ownership (i.e. tax statement, deed, title)
 - B. Lot Diagram that includes lot lines and footage, street names, existing structures on property, proposed fence location, and distance from all side of buildings to property lines.
 - *C.* Indicate the height of the fence. If there is going to be different heights, please indicate where the different heights will be located.
 - D. Indicate the type of fence (chain link, picket, etc.)
- Your application will be evaluated using the Village of Paw Paw Code of Ordinances Chapter 42, Article V, section 42-405
 - A. You are allowed to put up a solid fence or retaining wall in the side or rear yard that is not more that 6' in height. There is no setback for the side or rear yards, however, the fence <u>must</u> be placed on your property.
 - A fence can be put in the front yard, but it cannot be more than 50% solid (picket, chain link), and less than 4' in height.
 - C. The finished side of your fence may be facing you or your neighbor.

The setback of the fence in the front yard depends on what type of lot you own, whether it is an interior lot or a corner lot.

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Corner Lot:	There shall be no solid plant materials, walls or fences greater than
	30" within a triangle created: 25' from the intersection of the road
	rights-of-way.

Interior Lot: There shall be no solid plant materials, walls or fences greater than 30" within a triangle created: 15' from the driveway and the curb of the roadway (edge of pavement).

No wall or *fence* shall be greater than 30 inches in height within the triangle created:

- 15 feet from the intersection of a driveway and the roadway (edge of pavement), measured along the edge of the driveway and the curb line of the roadway from the point of intersection; and
- 25 feet from the intersection of street right-of-way lines, measured along both right-of-way lines from the point of intersection.
