Advertisement for Bid – Healer/Sealer Services

The Village of Paw Paw is seeking proposals from qualified firms for “healer/sealer” applications to three bridges in the Village during the Summer 2026 season.

Background:

Village consultants have inspected three bridges and recommended the following maintenance treatments.

Work to be done is as follows:

- **Michigan Street over the North Branch of the Paw Paw River**
 - This structure is a precast concrete I-beam bridge constructed in 1994. Healer/Sealer or Thin Epoxy overlay is needed to seal cracks in the deck as well as to the abutment joints to help keep the beam ends in good condition.
- **LaGrave Street over the East Branch of the Paw Paw River**
 - This structure is a precast concrete side by side box beam bridge, constructed in 1996. Healer/Sealer or Thin Epoxy overlay is needed to seal cracks in the deck after patching the minor spalls, as well as cleaning and resealing the abutment joint seals. Railings to be coated with concrete surface sealer to seal hairline cracking.
- **Power Plant Road over the north branch of the Paw Paw River**
 - This structure is a precast concrete side by side box beam bridge, constructed in 1988. Healer/Sealer is needed on the sidewalks, and concrete surface coating is needed on the railings.

Respondents should provide the following information to constitute a complete bid:

- A scope of services breakdown indicating how they will accomplish the above tasks
- A detailed, line-item budget corresponding to the scope of services
- Information related to proposed traffic control plan and devices
- Proposed binding agreement or contract
- Information related to experience and qualifications
- Evidence of liability insurance coverage in the amount of \$1,000,000 or more

- A statement indicating that bid prices are good for at least 30 days to allow time for bid award
- A statement indicating that the work can be scheduled and completed prior to August 15, 2026

Responses should be submitted no later than 12 Noon on Wednesday, May 27, 2026, via a hard copy mailed or delivered to the Village of Paw Paw, Attention: Village Clerk, 111 E Michigan Avenue, Paw Paw, MI 49047. Bids will be opened at that time. If a satisfactory bid is obtained, it is likely to be awarded at that evening's Village Council meeting.
