PROCESS

The Village of Paw Paw's approval is not the last step in the Land Combination process. Your application will be reviewed administratively by Paw Paw Village personnel. Should the application be complete and comply with Village requirements for land combinations, the Village will approve the application. The Village will notify the Paw Paw Township Assessor

Once you have received notification, you should contact the Van Buren County Register of Deeds Office to have the combination registered. The Register of Deeds is responsible for notifying the Van Buren County Treasurers office of the combination. You should inquire about this process when you contact the Register of Deeds. There is a delay in processing and depending upon the time involved you may still receive separate tax bills for each parcel to be combined. Again, the Township Assessor and the Van Buren County offices control the timing for such legal combination.

Be advised the Register of Deeds may require additional information than what the Village requires. Further, the Register of Deeds may have additional fees for the registration of combined or split parcels.
